

## Corrections to April 2008 Ida Lake Association Newsletter

### Serious Reminder: (Burning)

As you begin Spring and Fall work on your yard, please remember that the Douglas County Ordinance prohibits burning within 100 feet of the ordinary high water level of a general development and recreational development lake. The only exception would be a recreational wood burning campfire with a fire ring less than three feet in diameter, designed to enclose ash for removal.

If any amount of burning is done (other than a recreational campfire) a fire permit must be obtained. EPA doesn't allow burning of any garbage including paper and cardboard. Only allowed burning would be vegetative matter such as leaves, brush, and unpainted and unstained wood.

Home owners are responsible for smoke control. If you are burning, and the wind changes, and smoke is going to a neighbor's home, you must immediately Stop Burning.
